- 7. All words must be spelled correctly.
- 8. Poster must look neat, not messy
- 9. Points will be given for completed posters. This is a required assignment.
- 10. 3-D models may be used on the poster, but nothing too heavy that will fall off the paper.
- 11. Poster will be on white 12x18 paper provided by the teacher.
- 12. Posters will be judged by the firemen, and cash awards have been given in the past for the winning posters from 5th and 6th grades. Winners will have their pictures in the paper. We are excited to see what creative ideas you can come up with! Posters will have to be completed at home and returned to school on or before the due date.
